Knowledge Points

1. The importance of a personal and direct relationship with Jesus in worship

- **Superiority of Jesus** The speaker asserts that there is nothing better than Jesus, emphasizing his paramount importance.
- **Evolution of Worship** The speaker notes a shift from singing about Jesus to singing directly to Jesus, highlighting a more personal approach to worship.

- **Encouragement amidst negativity** The intent is to provide encouragement in times of prevalent negativity.
- **Importance of hearing from God** The speaker discusses the significance of being in a restful state to hear God's voice clearly, avoiding confusion and unrest.
- **Role of John the Baptist** John the Baptist is highlighted as an example of an unconventional figure used by God, emphasizing the need to listen to God's choices.
- **Critique of religious leaders** The Pharisees and Sadducees are criticized for their rejection of John's message due to their desire for recognition and status.

3. The importance of genuine spirituality, obedience, and transformation in serving God.

- **External appearances do not define spiritual roles** The speaker emphasizes that looking like a preacher, such as wearing a suit and tie, does not necessarily make one a true preacher.
- **God seeks receptive hearts** God is described as looking for individuals who are open to His words and willing to let Him lead, even when His messages are challenging to hear.
- **Transformation through God** The speaker discusses how God is in the business of changing people, shaping them into the vessels He intends them to be for His glory.

- **Credit and glory belong to God** When miracles or healing occur through prayer, the glory should be attributed to God, not the individuals through whom He works.
- **Avoiding past mistakes** The speaker mentions the importance of learning from historical errors where individuals took glory for themselves instead of giving it to God.
- **Obedience is crucial** Using the biblical example of Saul and Samuel, the speaker illustrates the importance of obedience to God's commands over mere sacrifice.
- **Consequences of disobedience** King Saul's failure to completely obey God's commands led to his loss of anointing and position.
- **Repentance and restoration** David, unlike Saul, repented after his mistakes, which is highlighted as crucial for maintaining a relationship with God.
- **David's heart for God** David is portrayed as a true worshipper and a man after God's own heart, exemplified even in his youth as a shepherd.
- **David's preparation for Goliath** The speaker narrates how David's earlier experiences, like killing a bear and a lion, prepared him for the confrontation with Goliath.

4. Reliance on God's strength and love in overcoming challenges

- **David's confrontation with Goliath** David, perceived as small and incapable, confronts Goliath with stones and a sling, demonstrating reliance on God rather than physical strength.
- **David's reliance on God** David's confidence and strength were derived from his faith in God, learned while tending sheep and worshipping.

- **God as a constant and loving presence** The teaching emphasizes that God remains constant, sovereign, and loving amidst worldly chaos, never failing those who trust in Him.
- **Encouragement to trust in God** Listeners are encouraged to trust in God's everlasting love and support, regardless of external circumstances.
- **Call to worship and affirmation** The speaker invites the audience to affirm their faith and trust in God through exclamations like 'Amen' and 'Hallelujah.'

5. The importance of trusting in God's timing and sovereignty in life's processes and endeavors.

- **David's repentance** David failed but fully repented and sought God's presence earnestly.
- **Importance of God's timing** The teaching emphasizes the significance of recognizing and trusting in God's timing over our own.
- **God's sovereignty in ministry growth** It is highlighted that the growth of the ministry is according to God's plan, regardless of current size.
- **Endurance and trust in God** Believers are encouraged to remain patient and trust in God's process and timing.

6. The importance of patience, humility, and obedience in fulfilling divine purpose

- **Relocation and divine purpose** The speaker discusses being placed by God in New York, despite initial reluctance, suggesting a divine purpose in locations and situations.
- **God's use of the humble** The speaker emphasizes that God prefers to use those who acknowledge they don't have much

to offer, as it allows God to work through them more effectively.

- **Importance of waiting** Waiting is highlighted as a difficult but necessary discipline, essential for spiritual renewal and receiving God's instructions.
- **Consequences of impatience** The speaker uses the example of the Israelites creating a golden calf to illustrate the negative outcomes of impatience and not waiting for divine guidance.
- **Adherence to divine rules** The necessity of following God's rules without bending them is stressed, using the example of Saul and everyday temptations like speeding.
- **Divine provision and assurance** The speaker reassures that God will provide for needs according to His riches and fulfill His promises.
- **Reflection on personal loss** The speaker reflects on the loss of his wife and how personal hardships are also within God's plan.
- **Critique of modern conveniences** The speaker critiques fast food as a symbol of society's impatience and contrasts it with the value of a home-cooked meal or waiting for quality.

7. The teaching discusses the themes of divine command, human disobedience, deception by Satan, and the eternal consequences of one's actions, emphasizing the importance of faith and adherence to God's plan.

- **Disobedience to God** The teaching discusses the disobedience of eating the forbidden fruit, which was against God's command, leading to consequences.

- **Satan's deception** It is highlighted that Satan deceives by questioning God's words, a tactic that continues to affect believers' faith today.
- **God's omnipresence** God is described as being present in all circumstances, whether in times of prosperity (mountains) or adversity (valleys).
- **Spiritual growth** The teaching emphasizes that God is involved in the growth of individuals, nurturing and revealing His plans gradually.
- **God's plan** It is asserted that God has a unique plan for everyone, which He reveals bit by bit.
- **Misinterpretation of scriptures** The speaker criticizes cults for altering biblical scriptures, particularly removing references to hell to suit their beliefs.
- **Consequences of actions** The teaching warns that decisions against God's will, especially those undermining His chosen people, lead to divine repercussions.
- **Eternal damnation** A stern warning about the eternal consequences of failing to repent, specifically being cast into the lake of fire.

8. The importance of spiritual wealth and trust in God's justice and timing over material success and human judgment.

- **Criticism of other religious texts** The speaker criticizes groups that modify or reject parts of the Bible and create their own religious texts, such as the Book of Mormon.
- **Encouragement from Psalms** The speaker uses Psalm 37 to encourage the audience, emphasizing trust in God and patience.

- **Warnings against envy and materialism** The speaker warns against envying the seemingly successful, mentioning the misery often found in wealthy and famous individuals.
- **Value of spiritual wealth over material wealth** The speaker highlights the superiority of spiritual wealth over material riches, emphasizing the importance of a relationship with God.
- **God's justice and protection** The speaker reassures that God is aware of injustices and will ultimately deliver and protect the righteous.
- **Prayer for leaders** The speaker urges the audience to pray for their leaders, regardless of personal feelings towards them, as instructed by the Bible.
- **The transient nature of the wicked** The speaker reflects on the temporary success of the wicked, contrasting it with the eternal inheritance of the righteous.
- **Resting in God** The speaker emphasizes the importance of resting in God as a way to avoid fretting and to trust in His timing.
- **God's laughter at the wicked** The speaker describes God as laughing at the wicked, knowing their end is near, which underscores God's sovereignty.
- **Salvation and strength from God** The speaker asserts that salvation and strength in times of trouble come from God, reinforcing the theme of divine support.

9. Spiritual transformation and the profound impact of God's love

- **Transformation through divine intervention** The speaker emphasizes that God will not leave individuals as they are but will transform them into a spiritual adulthood.

- **God's love and sacrifice** The speaker reflects on the profound love of God, highlighting that God's love is so immense that He sacrificed His life, with Jesus dying on the cross.
- **Anticipation of heavenly meeting** The speaker expresses a deep longing and excitement to meet God in heaven, anticipating an emotional encounter.
- **Emotional impact of divine realization** The speaker predicts that the realization of God's presence and actions might be overwhelming, leading to tears and a need for comfort.
- **Encouragement against negativity** The speaker urges the audience to focus on positivity and not dwell on the negative aspects commonly seen in the news.
- **Victorious Christian living** The speaker encourages living in victory through adherence to God's word and recognizing His love and plans for each individual.
- **Recognition of personal value** The speaker wants the audience to dwell on the fact that they are precious in God's sight and blessed by Him.
